# Worship This Week Sunday, April 9, 2023 Theme: "Who are you looking for?"

Series: Seeking: Honest Questions for a Deeper Faith Scripture Readings: Colossians 3:1-4, John 20: 1-18

## **Holy Week**

CANCELLED - Thursday, April 6th Maundy Thursday Service at 7:30 PM "Dinner with Jesus"

Maundy Thursday is observed during Holy Week on the Thursday before Easter. Maundy Thursday commemorates the Last Supper when Jesus shared the Passover meal with his disciples on the night before he was crucified. Maundy is derived from the Latin word mandatum, meaning "commandment," Maundy refers to the commands Jesus gave his disciples at the Last Supper: to love with humility by serving one another and to remember his sacrifice. This will be a casual service with conversation. Communion will be offered.

#### Friday, April 7th Good Friday Service at 10 AM

"Why Have You Forsaken me?"

Good Friday is observed on the Friday before Easter Sunday. On this day Christians commemorate the passion, or suffering, and death on the cross of the Lord, Jesus Christ. Many Christians spend this day in fasting prayer, repentance, and meditation on the agony and suffering of Christ on the cross. Our service will be held in the sanctuary and the choir will be singing.

#### Sunday, April 9th Sunrise Service at Dominion Garden's Park 8 AM.

We will be joined by St. John's United.

The park is located on Guelph street next to Christ the King Secondary School. Parking is available in the school lot or in the lot off Maple Ave.

This service will be a casual gathering with music, drama, reflection and prayer. Light refreshments will be offered afterwards.

## Sunday April 9 Easter Communion Service with Choir 10 AM "Who are You Looking for?"

Our weekly worship service is held in our sanctuary. The service will be meaningful as we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. We will be celebrating Communion in the service. A Children's program will be offered in this service for the entire family.

New Members will be joining the church on this day.


